



BARBADOS JUNIOR ROBOTICS CAMP

COACHES INVITED TO APPLY!

The **Barbados Junior Robotics Camp (BJRC)** is offered annually by the Caribbean Science Foundation (CSF), and it targets students between 9 and 13 years old who are passionately interested in robotics. The camp uses the facilities of the University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus and will run from July 10 to August 4, 2017 on weekdays 9 am to 3:30 pm.

The CSF is seeking qualified individuals for the positions of Camp Coaches. Coaches will be required to teach basic coding and STEM principles to the campers, as well as to provide supervision and mentoring.

Prospective coaches must attend a few coaching sessions in June and July, typically on Saturday mornings. The positions pay a modest stipend, and is a most rewarding experience.
