Please read the instructions below carefully before you begin to fill out this application.

- ❖ **Application Deadline: 15 September 2018 at 11:59 pm**
- ❖ **Camp Dates: Each Saturday, 22 September 2018 –15 December 2018 - (Level II not offered this session)**
- ❖ Level IA covers html only (website creation and development from scratch). Level IB focuses on mobile apps, but intermediate knowledge of html is required.
- ❖ Applicants must be Caribbean citizens.
- ❖ Persons less than 14 years old on September 1, 2018 are not eligible to apply.
- ❖ Targeted applicants are: (1) students between 14 and 18 years of age, (2) out-of-school and at-risk youth up to 30 years of age, (3) disabled individuals, and (4) secondary school science and mathematics teachers (of any age). **Girls are especially invited to apply.** If space is available after the targeted applicants are selected, the Admissions Committee may admit others of any age based on the Committee's assessment of the applicant's ability to keep up with the pace of the workshop.
- ❖ Please note that the applicant needs to secure two letters of recommendation for his/her application to be considered; so please begin the process early so your chosen references have as much time as possible to prepare their letters.
- ❖ Also note that the applicant has to write two compelling essays as part of the application package.
- ❖ Either fill out Web-based application form (**preferred**) or download, print, attach and e-mail to the CSF the paper version of the application form (on pages 3-5 below). The **preferred** Web-based application components can be filled out on-line at the links below:

- ❖ Make sure your full name appears on supplementary documents/attachments that you send in
- ❖ Please type your responses on such documents (handwritten applications are not acceptable). Type N/A for questions which are not applicable.
- ❖ *Please name your attachments to reflect their content. Attachments with file names such as "scan 001" could cause your attachment to be misfiled. Please name your attachments using the following format "2018 coding camp application-your first name-your last name-document name".*
- ❖ *Attachments with the content upside down will annoy most reviewers. Please make sure the content on your attachments are upright and legible.*
- ❖ Applications will be rejected if incomplete or uploaded/emailed later than **15 September, 2018**.
- ❖ Use the checklist (below) of required supporting materials to help you complete your package.
- ❖ Page 2 of this form contains (your signed application verification) and it must be submitted as part of your application package by e-mail to csfhdq@gmail.com.
- ❖ If admitted to the Camp, the Camp fee of BD\$ 500 is due in advance of participation in the Camp. Special arrangements for weekly or monthly payments can also be made.
